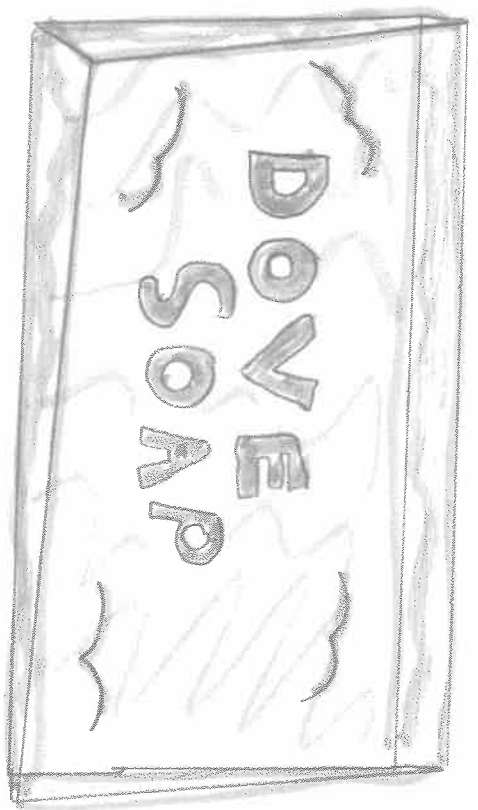


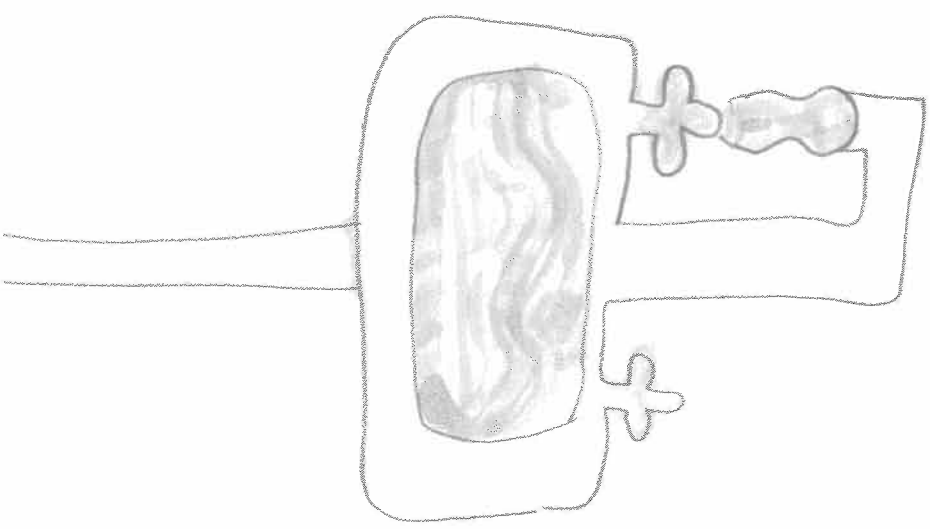
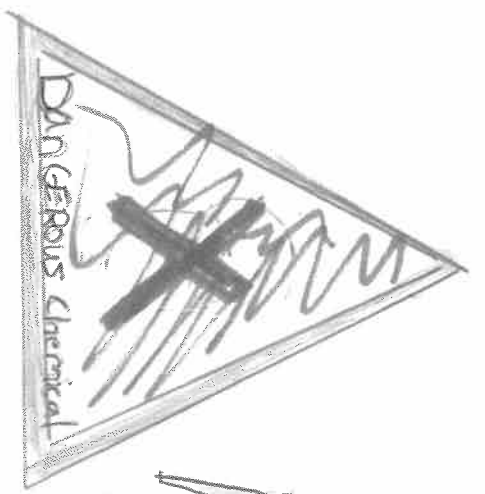
Rule 15. Odors

When observing odor, hold Material away from your face and fan a small amount of vapor toward your nose.





Reason: Chemicals can stay on the desk and harm the next class, & examples: fashers, ~~ch~~, red spots, ect.

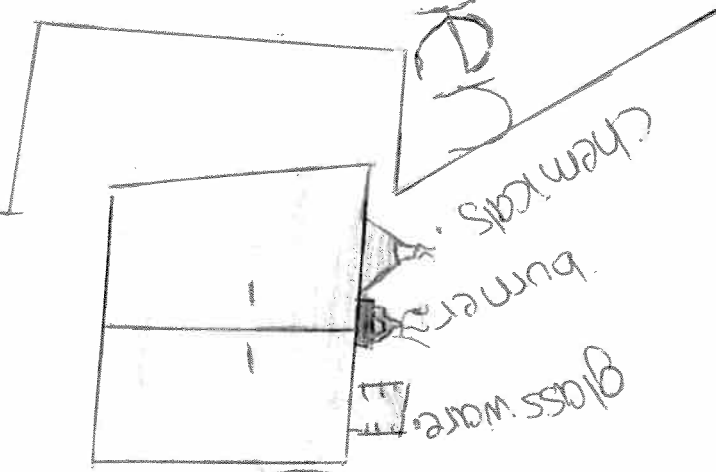


Wear Goggles When

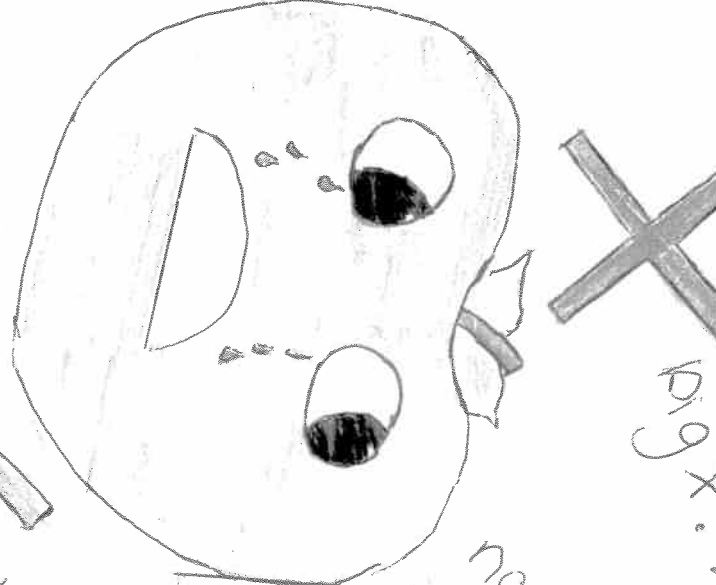
Indicated -

You could seriously hurt your eyes!!!

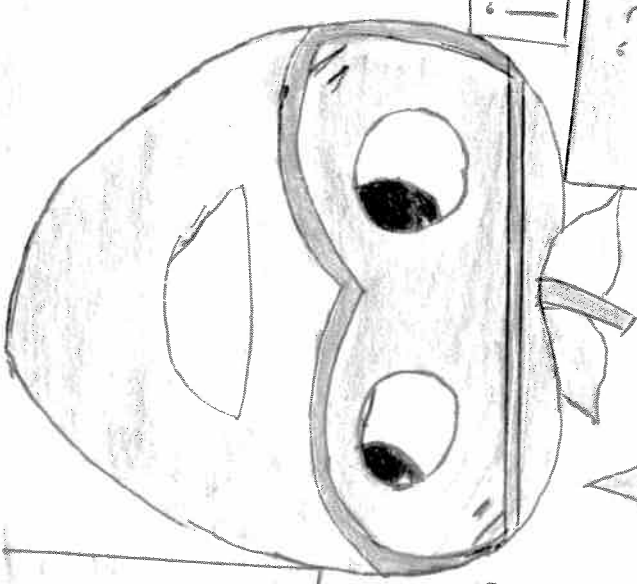
